Wallace Community College-Dothan (WCCD) is supported by two Foundations located on the Sparks Campus and on the Wallace Campus. The Wallace Community College (WCC) Sparks Foundation and the Wallace Foundation were established to seek and secure resources beyond the state and local revenues for the purpose of supporting education scholarships and other program needs of the College. The WCC Foundations build long-range security for the College through various programs that provide scholarships, build community partnerships, promote employee involvement, and host fundraising and friend-raising events. Events include annual spring golf tournaments, fall scholarship fundraiser gala, and virtual scholarship fundraiser.

Our students are supported by the WCC Foundations' scholarship program, which recognizes their hard work, provides encouragement to persist in their studies, and gives them hope they can achieve their educational dreams. The impact of the scholarship program is significant to the success of WCCD students. 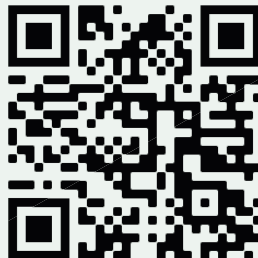

PRESIDENT'S CLUB
